## *Water Act*

### CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority is hereby authorized to divert and store water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Williston Lake and storage is at the British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority Wetland Demonstration Site 34 (Beaver Pond).
- b) The storage site and the point of diversion are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is April 10, 2013.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is conservation (habitat enhancement).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be held in storage is 12,985 cubic metres per year.
- f) Water may be held in storage throughout the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the conservation project of the licensee within Permit over Crown Land (PCL) 26011, which is the PCL for the storage of water from the Peace River in the reservoir of Williston Lake. The works are appurtenant to Park Use Permit No. 106689 which allows for the construction and maintenance of the water control structure within the Heather-Dina Lakes Park.
- h) The authorized works are reservoir (Wetland Demonstration Site 34 - Beaver Pond) and berm which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2017. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) The works authorized under clause (h) hereof shall be maintained to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the Water Act.

- k) This licence is only valid as long as Park Use Permit No. 106689 is in good standing.
