CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Olesen Creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is April 16, 1962.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is fire protection.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for fire protection purpose is 9.09219 cubic meters (2,000 gallons) a day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Block 1, District Lots 608 and 2177, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 12045, Except Part Dedicated Road on Plan BCP33669.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, screened intake, pipe, and dry fire hydrant which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2017. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) This Licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence C121473.

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
