

Province of British Columbia Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The Ministry of Forests, Lands and Natural Resource Operations, as represented by Ralph Thomas Thomsen and Irene Thomsen is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The streams on which the rights are granted are Edgar Spring and Lloyd Spring.
- b) The points of diversion are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is June 7, 1955.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is industrial (stock watering).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for industrial (stock watering) is 3.40957 cubic metres (747.3 gallons) per day from Edgar Spring and 3.40957 cubic metres (747.3 gallons) per day from Lloyd Spring.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the stock watering project of the licensee within Section 6, Township 14, Range 22, West of the 6th Meridian, Kamloops Division Yale District.
- h) The authorized works are two diversion structures (one for each source), pipes and a trough which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued under the *Water Act* (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.

- k) The industrial stock watering purpose authorized by this licence is for use outside the wetted perimeter of the source in a trough located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- 1) This Licence is issued in substitution of Water Licence C022977.
