Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is/are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Watson Bar Creek.
- b) The points of diversion are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is June 7, 1989.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are irrigation and industrial (stockwatering).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for irrigation purpose is 111,013.20000 cubic metres (90 acre feet) per annum and the maximum quantity which may be used for industrial (stockwatering) purpose is 4.5461 cubic metres (1,000 gallons) per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used for irrigation purpose is April 1st to September 30th and for industrial (stockwatering) purpose is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is District Lot 4698 Lillooet District except Plan KAP61253 of which 12.141 hectares (30 acres) may be irrigated.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structures, ditches, settling ponds, pump, pipe and irrigation system which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2017. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full

compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.

- k) The industrial stockwatering purpose authorized by this licence is for use outside the wetted perimeter of the source in a trough located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- l) This Licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence 102746.
