

Province of British Columbia Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Barlow Creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is April 21, 1995.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is irrigation.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 1,233.9000 cubic meters (10 acre feet) per annum. The maximum withdrawal rate is 0.0150 cubic metres per second (0.53 cubic feet second).
- f) Water may be used from April 1st to June 15th.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the South West 1/4 of District Lot 4375, Cariboo District except plans 31003 and 32306.
- h) The authorized works to be constructed are diversion structure, measuring devices, pump, pipe and sprinkler system, which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2017. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.

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- k) During the period of water diversion, a flow of water must be maintained in the stream for the instream resource. the flow required to maintain the instream resource is 2.76 cfs (1030 igpm) for the months of April and June and 5.53 cfs (2060 igpm) for the month of May.
- 1) This Licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water licence 109563, in part.
