

Province of British Columbia Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Hupel Creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 27th November, 2013.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are domestic and stockwatering.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for domestic purpose is 4.54 cubic metres (1000 gallons) per day and the maximum quantity which may be used for stockwatering purpose is 1.82 cubic metres (400 gallons) per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the Southeast 1/4 of Section 7 Township 19 Range 6 West of the 6th Meridian Kamloops Division Yale District.
- h) The authorized works are a stream flow measuring devise, diversion structure, flow diversion meter and pipe which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2017. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) The licensee shall install a stream flow measuring device to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the Water Act.
- k) The licensee shall retain flow meter records for inspection upon request by an Engineer under the Water Act.

- 1) This licence does not authorize the diversion of water for domestic and stockwatering purpose when the water flow of Hupel Creek falls below 0.5 litres (0.11 gallons) per second.
- m) This licence authorizes the use of water for domestic purpose in two dwellings located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- n) The diversion and use of water from this license is only permitted when the diversion and use of water from CL131252 is not being exercised.
- o) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
