CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream(s) on which the rights are granted is Montizambert Creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is December 14, 2006.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is domestic.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 4.54609 cubic metres (1,000 gallons) a day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Block I, Except: Firstly Part in Statutory Right of Way Plan 19066, Secondly: Part on Highway Plan 45, District Lot 2365, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 11180 (PID 009-131-655).
- h) The authorized works are screened intake, pipe and pump, which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2016. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence authorized the use of water for domestic purpose in one dwelling (duplex), located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- k) This licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence C122444.
