

## Province of British Columbia Water Act

## CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert, use and store water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Borgia Spring with storage in ponds.
- b) The points of diversion are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is January 3, 1974.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are irrigation, industrial (stockwatering) and storage.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be stored is 32810.834 cubic metres (26.5 acre feet) per year, the maximum quantity of water which may diverted for irrigation purpose is 104846.65 cubic metres (85 acre feet) per year and the maximum quantity of water which be diverted for industrial (stockwatering) is 5.9098 cubic metres (1,300 gallons) per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be stored is the whole year and the period of the year during which the water may be used for irrigation purpose is from April 1st to September 30th and for industrial (stockwatering) is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is District Lot 2353 and District Lot 528, Lillooet (formerly Cariboo) District except Plans 26922, 31930, 37692 and KAP45218.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, ditch, pump, pipe, sprinkler system, dams and ponds which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.

- j) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
- k) This Licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water licences C049048 and C049049 in part.
