



# Province of British Columbia *Water Act*

## CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Beyer Pond.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is September 21, 1990.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is industrial (stockwatering).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 2.273 cubic metres (500 gallons) per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the Northwest 1/4, Section 4, Township 85, Range 16, West of the Sixth Meridian, Peace River District.
- h) The authorized works are a dugout which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This Licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water licence 101393.
