CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The holders of a Crown Land tenure within Land Act file 3400073 covering the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is the Sunburst Reservoir.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is April 11, 1994.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are snow making, industrial (enterprise), and fire protection.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for snow making is 110,243.70052 cubic metres (89.38 acre feet) per year and the maximum quantity which may be used for industrial (enterprise) use is 9.0922 cubic metres (2000 gallons) per day and the amount of water which may be used for fire protection is the quantity necessary to extinguish a fire.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used for snow making is October 1-March 31 and for industrial (enterprise) and fire protection is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is that portion of Tod Mountain Controlled Recreational Area, as described under Section 17 of the Land Act by Reserve No. 85362, established November 25th, 1985, lying right of McGillivray Creek.
- h) The authorized works are a diversion structure, flow measuring device, pipeline, pumphouse, water treatment facility and three standpipes which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.

- j) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
- k) Any water diverted and used pursuant to this licence during the period from January 1-December 31, must be taken from storage provided in the reservoir authorized under licence C131505 (File 3002683).
- l) This Licence is issued in substitution of C120237, in part.
