



Province of British Columbia *Water Act*

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Fraser River.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is October 27th, 1964.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is industrial (pulp mill).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 2.209 cubic metres (78 cubic feet) per second.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is District Lot 824 except Plan A2282 and District Lot 817 except the Northerly 804.64 metres of the West 241.392 metres, Parcel A (30096M) and except Plans A1743 and 17194, Parcel A (30096M) of District Lot 817 except Plans A1743 and 17194, all of Cariboo District.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, pumps, pipeline, screened intake and tank which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This Licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water licence 103913.
