

Province of British Columbia Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert, use and store water as follows:

- a) The streams on which the rights are granted are Stoney Creek and the reservoir is Honour Pond.
- b) The points of diversion and storage are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is April 4th, 1975.
- d) The purposes for which the water is to be used are irrigation, stockwatering and storage.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be stored is 67,841.50 cubic metres (55 acre feet) per annum and the maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for irrigation purpose is 55507.0 cubic metres (45 acre feet) per annum and the maximum quantity which may be used for stockwatering purpose is 0.909 cubic metres (200 gallons) per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be stored is the whole year and the period of year during which water may be diverted for irrigation purpose is from April 1 to September 30 and for stockwatering purpose is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is District Lot 2041, Cariboo District, except Plan 13920.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, dam, flume, pipe, sprinkler system and ditch which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) The rights granted hereunder are exercisable only during such time as the works authorized under this licence or any licence issued in substitution thereof, are being maintained to the satisfaction of the Assistant or Regional Water Manager.
