

## Province of British Columbia Water Act

## CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The City of Penticton is hereby authorized to divert, store and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is James Creek and storage is in Howard Lake.
- b) The storage site and the points of diversion and re-diversion are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 14th June, 2013.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are storage and irrigation.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for storage is 86,000 cubic metres (70 acre feet) and the maximum quantity which may be used for irrigation purpose is 308,000 cubic metres (250 acre feet).
- f) The period of the year during which water may be diverted into storage is 1st October until 15th June, and the stored water may be used for irrigation purpose 1st April to 30th September.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is all irrigable lands within the boundaries of the Corporation of the City of Penticton.
- h) The authorized works are screened intake, control dam, diversion channel, pipe, saddle dam, and reservoir which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to 31st December, 2017. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.

j) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
