

Province of British Columbia Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert, use and store water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Kinkade Brook, and storage is in a dugout.
- b) The point of diversion and storage structure are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is December 17, 1963.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are storage and domestic (watering of garden).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for domestic (watering of garden) purpose is 2.27 cubic metres per day. The maximum quantity of water which may be held in storage is 200 cubic metres per year.
- f) The period of the year during which water may be used for domestic (watering of garden) purpose is the whole year, the period of the year during which the water may be used for storage purpose is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is District Lot 787, Sayward District, except those parts in Plans 27216 and 27217.
- h) The authorized works are pump, pipe, and dugout which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued in substitution of Final Water Licence F044135.
