

Province of British Columbia Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Gissing Creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is November 21, 2013.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is power (residential).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for power (residential) purpose is 0.002 cubic metres per second.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is November 1 to April 30.
- g) The land upon which water is to be used is Lot 4, Section 4, Range 7, Comiaken District, Plan 9224 on which a powerhouse is situated, and the land to which the licence is appurtenant is said land.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, penstock, powerhouse, and tailrace which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) The power generation pursuant to this licence may be supplied to one dwelling on Lot 4, Section 4, Range 7, Comiaken District, Plan 9224 as shown on the attached plan.
- k) The term of this licence is 40 years from the date of issuance of this licence.
