## Water Act

### CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Colpman Creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is April 1, 1946.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is domestic.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for domestic purpose is 4.54 cubic metres per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot 105, Malahat District, except the Northerly 9.52 chains thereof, and except Parcel A (DD 186208-I) and except parts in Plans 8925, 16967 and 499 RW.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, pipe and tank which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence authorizes the use of water for domestic purpose in one dwelling located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- k) This licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence C017235.
