

## Province of British Columbia Water Act

## CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The holder(s) of the placer tenure to which this licence is appurtenant is/are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Barrington River.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is April 2, 2014.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is mining (placer).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for placer mining is 0.028 cubic metres per second (1.0 c.f.s.).
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is March 1 to November 30.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the mining project located within Placer Tenure 559167, Liard Mining Division.
- h) The authorized works are screened intake, pump, pipe, wash plant, and settling pond which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) All waste water generated from the washing of gravels must be directed through a settling pond system to remove suspended solids before being returned to the stream.
- k) All mined or otherwise disturbed ground surfaces including cut banks and fill slopes shall be stabilized to prevent tailings, forest cover, top soil and debris from entering into water courses.
- 1) The riparian (vegetation) zone adjacent to Barrington River shall be protected from all activities associated with placer mining. Placer operations within Placer Tenure 559167 shall be prohibited within 10 metres of the high water mark measured from both sides of

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
the stream, including the bed and banks of the stream

- m) The diversion of water authorized under this licence may be restricted or prohibited at any time by an Order in writing of an Engineer under the *Water Act*, in order to maintain a minimum flow in the stream.
- n) This licence is valid so long as Approval of Work System No. 14-0100230-0627 and Permit Approving Reclamation Program No. P-1-659 are current and in good standing.
