

## Province of British Columbia Water Act

## CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is/are hereby authorized to store water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is the San Jose River and the reservoir is Lac La Hache.
- b) The storage site is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is November 14th, 1924.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is to be used is set out in Conditional Water Licence No. 131740.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be stored is 161,093.8 cubic metres (130.6 acre feet) per annum.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be stored is October 1st to June 15th.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is set out in Conditional Water Licence No. 131694.
- h) The authorized works are a dam which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) The dam authorized under clause (h) is subject to the Dam Safety Regulations and shall be designed, constructed and maintained to the satisfaction of a Dam Safety Officer under the Water Act and in accordance with the Canadian Dam Association Guidelines.
- k) The construction and or reconstruction of the works authorized in clause (h) shall not commence until plans prepared by a professional engineer registered in British Columbia have been submitted to and written leave to commence construction granted by an Engineer under the Water Act.

- This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
- m) This Licence is issued in substitution of Final Water Licence No. 009527, in part.
