CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is/are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Beaton Creek.
- b) The points of diversion and re-diversion are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 20 July 2011.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is domestic.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for domestic purpose is 2.27305 cubic metres per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the NW 1/4 SEC 7 TWP 20 RGE 19 W6M KDYD, except KAP 24173.
- h) The authorized works are pump, pipe, balancing reservoir, ditch, screened intake and flow measuring device, which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been mostly completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) The rights granted herein are exercisable only during such times as the licensee remains a member of the Beaton Creek Water Users' Community, and as long as storage and diversion works under C116209, or any licence issued in substitution thereof, are being maintained and operated to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the Water Act.
- k) The licensee shall install a flow measuring device to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the Water Act.
- l) The licensee shall retain flow meter records for inspection upon request by an Engineer under the Water Act.

- m) This licence authorizes the use of water for domestic purpose in one dwelling located approximately as shown on the attached plan.

- n) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
