CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

Fisheries and Oceans Canada (DFO) are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Oyster River.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is August 6, 1985.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is conservation (fish habitat enhancement).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for conservation purpose is 0.226 cubic metres per second.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the conservation project of the licensee within Lot 1, Block 29, Comox District, Plan EPP7782.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, pipe, weirs, spawning and rearing channels which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) The diversion of water authorized under this licence may be restricted or prohibited at any time by an Order in writing of an Engineer under the *Water Act*, in order to maintain a minimum flow in the stream.
- k) This licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence C063951.
