
## *Water Act*

### CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Okanagan Lake.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is June 11, 2014.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is domestic.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted domestic use is 2.27 cubic meters per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot 2 Sections 15 and 22 Township 28 Similkameen Division Yale District Plan 6042.
- h) The authorized works are pump, pipe, and deep intake which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2017. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence authorizes the use of water for domestic purpose in one dwelling located approximately as shown on the attached plan.

- k) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
- l) The periphery of Okanagan Lake serves as a spawning and rearing area for fish. To protect this habitat the fisheries Management Program requires the following:
- (1) The water intake shall be located below: 339.0 metres (or 1112.20 feet), Geodetic Survey of Canada datum, and
  - (2) Screening requirements of [Section 30] of the federal Fisheries Act must be met, and
  - (3) Work below the high water mark, elevation 343 metres (1125 feet), Geodetic Survey of Canada datum is to be carried out between Jul 22 - Aug 24 in any calendar year; approval from the Fisheries Management Program of the Ministry of Environment will be required to work outside of this period.
