

Province of British Columbia Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert, use and store water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Mawhinna Creek and the storage structures are a tank and cistern.
- b) The point of diversion and the storage structures are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is August 27, 1952.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are domestic, industrial (residential lawn and garden watering) and storage.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for domestic purpose is 2.25 cubic metres per day, the maximum quantity of water which may be diverted to fill the storage structures is 9.09 cubic metres per year, and the maximum quantity of water which may be used for industrial (residential lawn and garden watering) purpose is 9.09 cubic metres per year, subject to the water being available from storage.
- f) The period of the year during which water may be diverted for domestic purpose is the whole year. The period of the year during which water may be diverted into storage is October 1 to March 31, and the stored water may be used for industrial (residential lawn and garden watering) purpose from April 1 to September 30.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot B, Section 17, Ranges 4 and 5 East, North Salt Spring Island, Cowichan District, Plan VIP62933.
- h) The authorized works are hydraulic ram, pipe, tank, cistern, pump and sprinklers which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2018. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) The licensee may also use an additional 22.7 cubic metres of water a day for the operation of a hydraulic ram until said 22.7 cubic metres or any part thereof is required under any other licence, whether issued heretofore or hereafter. The water used in operating the said hydraulic ram shall be returned to the stream immediately after use.

- k) This licence authorizes the use of water for domestic purpose in one dwelling located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- 1) This licence is issued in substitution of Final Water Licence F111602.
