CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Ruby Lake.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is March 6, 1991.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is enterprise (motel and campsite) and domestic.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for enterprise (motel and campsite) purpose is 15.9113 cubic meters (3,500 gallons) a day for domestic purpose is 4.5461 cubic meters (1,000 gallons) a day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot 1, District Lot 3988, Plan 14653 and District Lot 3988 except those portions in Plans 12095, 14653, 15401, 15813, 16650 and 17325, both within Group 1, New Westminster District.
- h) The authorized works are screened intake, pipe, submersible pump and UV Treatment facility which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence authorizes the use of water for domestic purpose in 3 dwellings located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- k) This Licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence C072776, "in part."
