CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is/are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Ruby Lake.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is March 6, 1991.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is enterprise (restaurant) and domestic.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for enterprise (restaurant) purpose is 22.73045 cubic meters (5,000 gallons) a day and for domestic purpose is 2.27305 cubic meters (500 gallons) a day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot 3, District Lot 3988, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 15813.
- h) The authorized works are screened intake, pipe, submersible pump and UV Treatment facility which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence authorizes the use of water for domestic purpose in one dwelling located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- k) This Licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence C072776, "in part."
