Whereas Conditional Water Licence No. C131956 authorizes the diversion and use of water from Nascall Lake for power (commercial) purpose and is appurtenant to the land on which the powerhouse is situated, described as that parcel or tract of land within District Lot 1594, Range 3, Coast District:

With respect to licence clause (o):

I hereby Order as follows:

1. This licence does not authorize the diversion of water for power (commercial) purpose when the water flow of the lower Nascall River falls below 2.2 cubic metres per second, measured at the present sill of the waterfall at the outlet of Nascall Lake.
2. This ramping rate of water discharged into the tailrace reach, from the powerhouse to the main stem of the lower Nascall River, shall be 2.5 centimetres per hour when fry are present, and 5.0 centimetres per hour otherwise. The licensee may operate the works in an alternate manner in the event of an emergency, however, notification must be provided to this office in the event of emergency operations.
