

## Province of British Columbia Water Act

## FINAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to store water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Barnes Creek and storage is in Willard and Barnes Lakes.
- b) The storage sites are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 10th April, 1894.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is storage.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be stored is 27,087.261 cubic metres (21.960 acre feet).
- f) The period of the year during which water may be diverted into storage is October 1 to June 30, and the stored water may be used for irrigation purpose during the period of April 1 to September 30.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is as set out in Conditional Water Licence 131444 and any licences issued in substitution thereof..
- h) The authorized works are dams which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) The dams authorized under clause (h) are subject to the Dam Safety Regulations and shall be designed, constructed and maintained to the satisfaction of a Dam Safety Officer under the Water Act and in accordance with the Canadian Dam Association Guidelines.

- k) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
- 1) This Licence is issued in substitution of Final Water Licence 6908, in part.
