CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is/are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Adler Creek and the reservoir is the creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is October 9, 1981.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is storage and stockwatering.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for storage is 0.67 acre feet per year and the maximum quantity which may be diverted for stockwatering is 2.27305 m³ (500 gallons) per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is all year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant are Lot 2, District Lots 274 and 349, Range 5, Coast District, Plan PRP46428.
- h) The authorized works are dam, reservoir, intake, pump and pipe which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This Licence is issued in substitution of Water Licences C062415 and C062416.
- k) The rights granted under this licence are subject to a water reserve established by Order in Council No. 372, dated 16th April, 1928.
