CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is/are hereby authorized to divert, use, and store water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Trickle Creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 19th September, 1984, and is subject to a reserve established by Order-in-Council No. 372/1928.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is irrigation.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for irrigation is 0.5 acre feet per annum.
- f) The period of the year during which water may be used is April 1st to September 30th.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is that portion of Lot C lying North and West of British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority Right-of-Way Plan 5311, District Lot 3449, Range 5, Coast District, of which 0.5 acres may be irrigated.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, pipe, storage tanks to a maximum capacity of 4.5m³ and sprinkler system, which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- k) This Licence is issued in substitution of Water Licence C061995.
- l) The diversion of water authorized under this licence may be restricted or prohibited at any time by an Order in writing of an Engineer under the *Water Act*, in order to maintain a minimum flow in the stream.
