

Province of British Columbia Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The holders of Special Use Permit S03457 and a part of District Lot 638, Nootka District held under a Crown Land tenure in lands file 0257490 to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Camas Creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is November 27, 2014.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is industrial (work camp).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for industrial (work camp) is 15.0 cubic metres per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Unsurveyed Crown land as held under Special Use Permit S03457, and that part of District Lot 638, Nootka District as held under Crown land file 0257490.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, pipe, hydrant and tanks which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) The licence will remain valid only for so long as a valid tenure exists for the land described in clause (g) herein, or the licensee acquires ownership of the said land.
