CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is\are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is South Thompson River.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is February 3, 1994.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are greenhouse, industrial (processing) and industrial (stockwatering).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for greenhouse purpose is 13.63830 cubic metres (3000 gallons) per day; for industrial (processing) purpose is 1.13653 cubic metres (250 gallons) per day; and for industrial (stockwatering) purpose is 2.27305 cubic metres (500 gallons) per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used for greenhouse, industrial (processing) and for industrial (stockwatering) purposes some is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot A Section 12 Township 20 Range 14 West of the 6th Meridian Kamloops Division Yale District Plan KAP78000 except Plan EPP29158.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, division box, pumphouse, pipe, flow measuring device, sprinklers, hydrant and trough which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2017. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of

all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.

- k) The industrial stockwatering purpose authorized by this licence is for use outside the wetted perimeter of the source in a trough located in the trough approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- l) The licensee shall install a flow measuring device to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the Water Act.
- m) The licensee shall retain flow meter records for inspection upon request by an Engineer under the Water Act.
- n) This Licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence 107717, in part.
