Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Franks Creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is June 12, 2014.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued is domestic and power (residential).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for domestic use is 2.27 cubic meters per day and the maximum quantity which may be used for power is 0.00025 cubic meters per second.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used for domestic is the whole year and for power is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is That Part Of The South west 1/4 Of Section 17 Which Lies To The South Of The South Bank Of Seymour Arm Of Shuswap Lake, Township 26, Range 7, West Of The 6th Meridian, Kamloops Division Yale District, Shown On A Plan Of Survey Of The South West 1/4 Of Said Township, Dated At Ottawa On April 29th, 1912.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, settling ponds, distribution system, pipe, powerhouse (including Pelton wheel generator) which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2018. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.

- j) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
- k) This licence authorizes the use of water for domestic purpose in one dwelling located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- l) The power generation pursuant to this licence may be supplied to one dwelling on That part Of The South west 1/4 Of Section 17 Which Lies To The South Of The South Bank Of Seymour Arm Of Shuswap Lake, Township 26, Range 7, West Of The 6th Meridian, Kamloops Division Yale District, Shown On A Plan Of Survey Of The South West 1/4 Of Said Township, Dated At Ottawa On April 29th, 1912, as shown on the attached plan.
- m) The rights granted herein are exercisable only during such times as the licensee remains a member of the Southside Water Users' Community.
