CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority is hereby authorized to divert, use and store water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is the Cheakamus River.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is March 7, 2014.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is fire protection.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for fire protection purpose is 416.4 cubic metres per year at a rate not to exceed 0.0145 cubic metres per second.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot A, (Reference Plan 4800) Skowishin Indian Reserve No. 7 and District Lot 6762, Group 1, New Westminster District.
- h) The authorized works are screened intake, pump, pipe and tank which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2018. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) The rights granted under this licence are subject to an Office Water Reserve RS46333, dated February 17, 2006.

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
