

Province of British Columbia Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The holder of Special Use Permit S23775 to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Yellow Cedar Creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is September 10, 2014.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is industrial (brake cooling).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for industrial (brake cooling) purpose is 9 cubic metres per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is that parcel or track of surveyed Crown land held under Special Use Permit S23775 within District Lot 2085, Rupert District, together with unsurveyed Crown land and land covered by water being part of the bed of Yellow Cedar Creek.
- h) The authorized works are pipe and tank which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence will remain valid only for so long as Special Use Permit S23775 is in good standing.
