CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The District of North Saanich is hereby authorized to divert and store water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Dominion Brook and storage is in two reservoirs.
- b) The points of diversion and storage sites are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is March 17, 1977.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are land improvement (aesthetic ponds) and land improvement (drainage).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be held in storage for land improvement (aesthetic ponds) purpose is 1078 cubic metres per year and the maximum quantity that may be diverted for land improvement (drainage) purpose is the whole flow, except for 0.364 cubic metres a day which is to provide water for Conditional Water Licence C041935.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be stored for land improvement (aesthetic ponds) is the whole year and the period of the year during which the water may be diverted for land improvement (drainage) is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant are the land improvement projects of the licensee within that part of Section 3, Range 3 East, shown on Plan 2125 Right-of-Way; those parts of Section 3, Range 3 East, except the Right-of-Way of the British Columbia Electric Railway containing 2.327 acres, more or less, as shown on Plan deposited under DD 25276, except part 2.1 acres in Plan 4 RW and except part in Plan 23813; and that part of the East 36 acres of Section 3, Range 2 East; all of North Saanich District as held under a lease between District of North Saanich and the Minister of Agriculture and Agri-Food and known as Dominion Brook Park.
- h) The authorized works are 2 dams, 2 reservoirs, 1 spillway, 2 culverts and 1 ditch which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) The dams authorized under clause (h) is subject to the Dam Safety Regulations and shall be designed, constructed and maintained to the satisfaction of a Dam Safety Officer under the *Water Act* and in accordance with the Canadian Dam Association Guidelines.
- k) This licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence C050522.
