
Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The holders of a Crown Land tenure within Land Act file 3407973 covering the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert, use and store water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Murray Creek and storage is in Pond 7, Pond 10 and Pond 13.
- b) The storage sites and the points of diversion and re-diversion are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is November 30, 2005.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are storage and watering.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted to fill the reservoir is 43,186.80966 cubic metres per year and the maximum quantity of water which may be used is 43,186.80966 cubic metres per year, subject to the water being available from storage.
- f) The period of the year during which water may be diverted into storage is November 1 to June 15, and the stored water may be used for watering during the period April 15 to September 30.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is the undertaking of the licensee within all that unsurveyed Crown Land in the vicinity of District Lot 6336, Kamloops Division Yale District, held under Land File 3407973.
- h) The authorized works are a culvert, pipe, pumphouses (3), storage ponds (3), water meters, sprinklers and spillways which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.

- j) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
- k) Any water diverted and used pursuant to this licence during the period from April 15-September 30 must be taken from storage provided in the reservoirs authorized under this licence or any licence issued in substitution thereof.
- l) The licensee shall install a flow measuring device to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the Water Act.
- m) The licensee shall retain flow meter records for inspection upon request by an Engineer under the Water Act.
