CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The holder of the Park Use Permit, and subsequent permits that take the place of Park Use Permit No. 106271, to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Sint'a K'aadxwa Gandlaay Creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is November 4, 2014.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is industrial commercial enterprise (floating fishing lodge).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for industrial commercial enterprise (floating fishing lodge) is 17.6 cubic metres per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is May 1 to September 30.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is that unsurveyed Crown foreshore or land covered by water being part of the bed of Englefield Bay located within Daawuuxusda Protected Area, as held under Park Use Permit No. 106271 and subsequent Park Use Permits that take the place of said permit, within Queen Charlotte District.
- h) The authorized works are pump, intake, and pipe which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being beneficially used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) The diversion of water authorized under this licence may be restricted or prohibited at any time by an Order in writing under the *Water Sustainability Act*, in order to maintain a minimum flow in a stream.
- k) This licence will remain valid only for so long as a valid Park Use Permit exists for the land described in clause (g) herein.
