CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The holder(s) of Placer Lease No. 576857 to which this licence is appurtenant is/are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

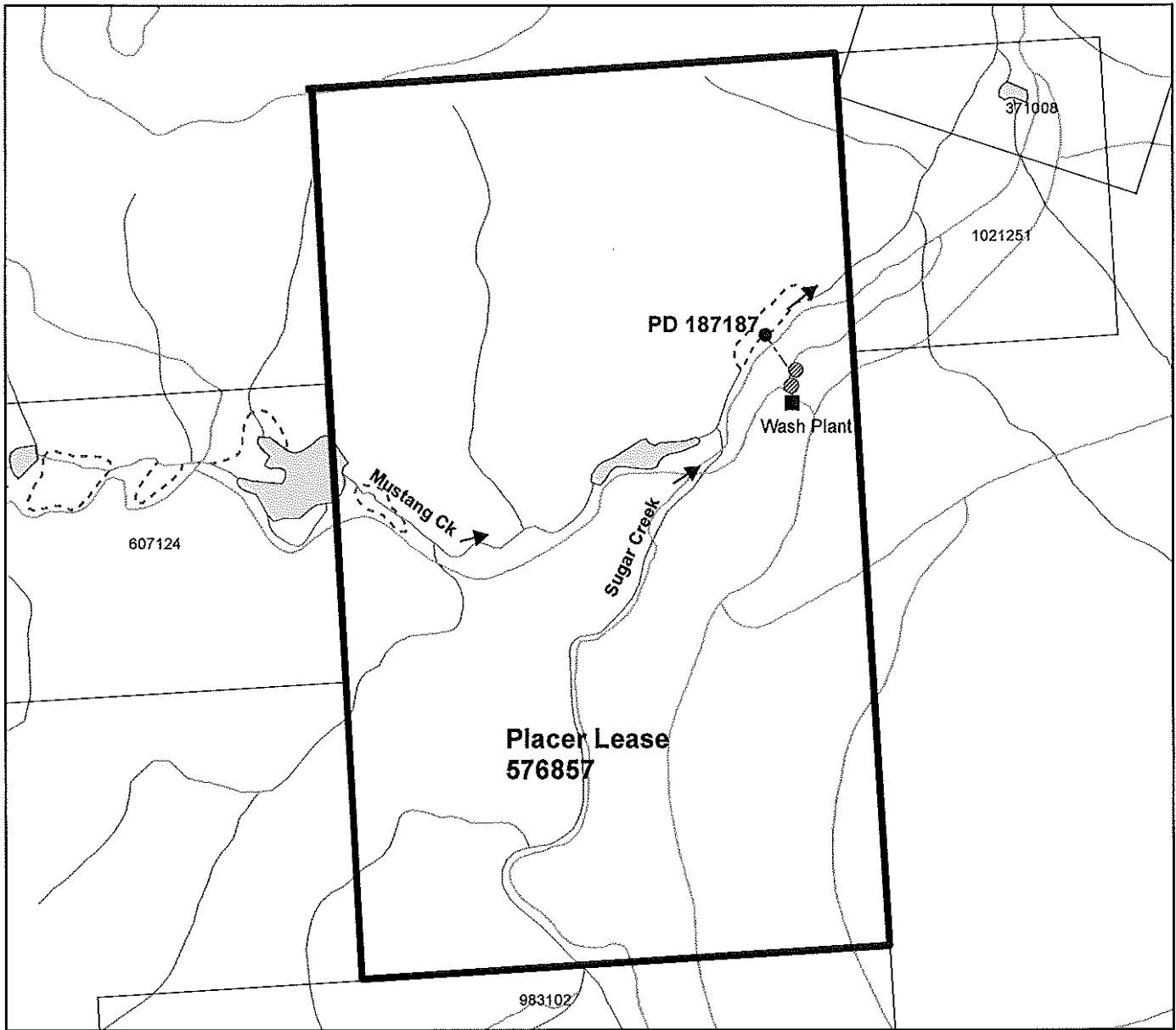
- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Sugar Creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is February 17, 2015.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is mining (placer).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for placer mining is 34,560 cubic metres per year at a rate not to exceed 0.02 cubic metres per second. The water shall be used for the replenishment of a closed re-circulatory system.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is from May 1st to October 31st.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the mining project of the licensee within Placer Lease 576857, Cariboo Mining District.
- h) The authorized works are screened intake, pump, pipe, wash plant and settling ponds which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2018. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) The diversion of water authorized under this licence may be restricted or prohibited at any time by an Order in writing of an Assistant Regional Water Manager under the Water Act, in order to maintain a minimum flow in the stream.
- k) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise

reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.

- 1) This licence is valid only as long as the Placer Lease No. 576857 is in good standing.




