Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Hazel Creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is December 18, 2014.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are domestic and power (residential).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for domestic is 2.273 cubic metres per day and for power (residential) is 0.102 cubic metres per second.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which water is to be used is Sublot 10, District Lot 362, Kootenay District, Plan X-40, Except (1) Parcel A (Reference Plan 127312-I), (2) RW Plan 524-V-1 and (3) Plans 4585, 5347, 5447 and 9117 on which a powerhouse is situated, and the land to which the licence is appurtenant is said land.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, penstock, pipe, powerhouse, tailrace and transmission line which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2018. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.

- k) This licence authorizes the use of water for domestic purpose in one dwelling located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- l) The power generation pursuant to this licence may be supplied to one dwelling as shown on the attached plan.
- m) This licence terminates on July 20, 2055. Prior to the termination date, the licensee may apply to the Comptroller of Water Rights or the Regional Water Manager in accordance with the provisions of the Water Act to amend this licence to extend its term.
