
Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is/are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Kosterling Creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is September 29, 2014.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is Power (residential).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 0.036 cubic metres per second.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which water is to be used and to which the licence is appurtenant is the land on which the powerhouse is to be situated, described as that part of District Lot 4407 Lillooet District lying south and east of Big Bar Road.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure with bypass provision, penstock, pipe, powerhouse, tailrace and transmission line which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2018. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.

- k) The diversion of water authorized under this licence may be restricted or prohibited at any time by an Order of an Engineer under the Water Act, in order to maintain a minimum flow in the stream.
- l) The licensee shall install a flow measuring device to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the Water Act.
- m) This licensee shall keep records on actual water use as directed by an Engineer under the Water Act and have all records available.
- n) The works authorized under clause (h) hereof shall be maintained to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the Water Act.
- o) Changes, modifications and maintenance to the works authorized under clause (h) hereof may be ordered at any time by an Engineer under the Water Act to ensure proper operations of said works.
- p) The diversion structure shall be constructed in such a way as to ensure a minimum flow of 0.108 cubic metres per second is retained in Kosterling Creek at all times.
- q) The water used in the generation of power shall be returned to the stream above any downstream points of diversion.
- r) The term of this licence is 40 years from the date of issuance of this licence.
