

## Province of British Columbia Water Act

## CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The City of Surrey is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Wills Brook.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is April 7, 2015.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is Industrial (sediment control).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for Industrial (sediment control) is total flow of the stream.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is that portion of Lot 17, Section 25, Township 1, New Westminster District, Plan EPP30469, as shown outlined in green on the attached plan.
- h) The authorized works are a settling pond and bank rip rap which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to February 1, 2018. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) The City of Surrey is permitted to perform regular sediment maintenance in the sediment trap, as specified in the "City of Surrey ("Licencee") Conditional Water Licence C132380, Water File 2003688 Erosion and Sediment Control Plan ("ESCP") For the Wills Brook Sediment Pond", dated January 13, 2016, which includes any revisions thereafter approved by the Regional Water Manager.

All crew that work on sediment removal must have read and understood the requirements under the ESCP. A copy of this ESCP must be available for inspection, upon request, when instream works are occurring.
