

Province of British Columbia Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of Mineral Claims 1027429 and 1027433 to which this licence is appurtenant is/are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Brucejack Lake.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is April 15, 2015.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is mining (processing ore).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for mining (processing ore) is 50,000 cubic metres per year, at a rate not exceeding 70 cubic metres per hour.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is whole year. During the period from December through April, the monthly maximum diversion shall not exceed 12,000 cubic metres.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the mining project of the licensee within Mineral Claims 1027429 and 1027433, Skeena Mining District.
- h) The authorized works are intake, pump and pipe which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2018. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) The licensee must operate the works authorized under clause (h) above in accordance with:
 (1) procedures ordered by an Engineer/Regional Water Manager under the *Water Act*, including any order for the regulation of the diversion, rate of diversion and use of water as may be required for the preservation of aquatic life and for the provision of flow for whatever activities; and

(2) any amendment of the procedures ordered by the Engineer/Regional Water Manager under the *Water Act*.

k) This licensee shall keep records on actual water use as directed by the Engineer/Regional Water Manager under the *Water Act* and have all records available.

1) The licensee shall retain flow meter records for inspection upon request by an Engineer/Regional Water Manager under the *Water Act*.
