

Province of British Columbia Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is the Cluxewe River.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is May 27, 1974.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is industrial (processing).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for industrial (processing) purpose is 22.7 cubic metres per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is that part of Lot 1, Sections 10, 15, 16 and 21, Township 2, Rupert District, Plan EPP2284, Lying to the left of the Cluxewe River, and located within the bounds of the Southwest ¼ of Section 21, Township 2, Rupert District.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, pump and pipe, which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence C044022.
