

## Province of British Columbia Water Act

## CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is/are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is the Bonaparte River.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 6th December, 1986.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is irrigation.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for irrigation is 61,674.093 cubic metres per annum.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is April 1 to September 30.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot 1 District Lots 41 and 4929 Lillooet District and of Sections 29 and 30 Township 23 Range 25 West of the 6th Meridian Kamloops Division Yale District of which 8.094 hectares may be irrigated.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, pipes, pump and sprinklers which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.

- k) The rights granted herein are exercisable only during such times as the licensee remains a member of the Bonaparte Dam Water Users' Community and as long as the works under Conditional Water Licence 103065, or any licence issued in substitution thereof, are being maintained and operated to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the Water Act.
- 1) The water authorized to be diverted and used under this licence must be taken from the storage provided in Bonaparte Lake under Conditional Water Licence 103065 or any licence issued in substitution thereof.
- m) The rights granted under this licence are subject to a water reserve established by Order in Council No. 979/1993 Bonaparte River and tributaries.
- n) This Licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence 119643.
