CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Gold River.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is February 27, 1961.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is industrial (processing).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for industrial (processing) purpose is 500 cubic metres per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is District Lot 74; Block A of District Lot 647, except that part in Plan VIP63654, Nootka District.
- h) The authorized works are intake, pump and pipe which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence C123448 in part.
