

## Province of British Columbia Water Sustainability Act

## CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Drinkwater Spring.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is July 3, 2014.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is Industrial Livestock and Animal: Stock Watering
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted and used under this licence is 3285 cubic metres annually subject to the following: The licensee shall maintain in the Drinkwater Spring, measured immediately downstream of the point of diversion:
  1. A minimum flow of .18 litres per second to meet an Environmental Flow Needs requirement for low risk withdrawal in a non-fish bearing stream.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is January 1st to December 31st.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot 1, District Lot 95, Kamloops Division Yale District, Plan 24228 and District Lot 95, Kamloops Division Yale District, Except Plan 24228.
- h) The authorized works are a, cistern, pump, pumphouse, pipe and troughs which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2019. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued under the *Water Sustainability Act* (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream or on an aquifer. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as

the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.

k) The industrial stockwatering purpose authorized by this licence is for use outside the wetted perimeter of the source in a trough located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
