CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure (or agent), of 301-640 Borland Street, Williams Lake, BC V2G 4T1 is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Bridge Lake.
- b) The points of diversion are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is July 15, 2015.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is Industrial - dust control (includes road compaction).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for dust control is 50.0 cubic metres per day and the withdrawal rate is not to exceed 0.95 cubic metres per minute.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is from the date of the signing of this licence to November 15, 2015.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is within the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure Right-of-Ways, in the Cariboo Region.
- h) The authorized works are portable pump, hose with screened intake and tanker truck.
- i) All work shall be done in a manner that minimizes the introduction of silt or other deleterious substances into Bridge Lake, its tributaries or other streams.
- j) The diversion of water authorized under this licence may be restricted or prohibited at any time by an Order in writing of a Regional Water Manager under the Water Act, in order to maintain a minimum flow in the stream and/or to resolve conflicts with other water licence holders on the stream.
- k) This licensee shall keep records on actual water use as directed by a Regional Water Manager under the Water Act and have all records available.
- l) A copy of this licence and supporting documentation shall be carried by the transport

vehicle within reach of the driver, and shall be produced to an Officer upon request.

- m) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
- n) No machinery shall be operated within the wetted perimeter of Bridge Lake.
- o) This licence terminates on November 15, 2015. Prior to the termination date, the licensee may apply to the Comptroller of Water Rights or the Regional Water Manager in accordance with the provisions of the Water Act to amend this licence to extend its term.
