CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is/are hereby authorized to use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Gallacher Spring.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 15th July, 1969.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is irrigation and domestic.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for irrigation purpose is 11,224.66800 cubic metres per year and the maximum quantity which may be used for domestic purpose is 1.89270 cubic metres per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used for irrigation purpose is 1st April to 30th September and for domestic purpose is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the land improvement project of the licensee within Lot A Section 23 Township 20 Osoyoos Division Yale District Plan KAP77445, of which 1.440 hectares may be irrigated.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, pump, pipe and sprinkler system, which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This Licence is issued in substitution of C037116, in part.

- k) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
