## *Water Act*

### CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Whistle Creek.
- b) The points of diversion are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 13th October, 1900.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is irrigation.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for irrigation is 64,140 cubic meters per year.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is 1st April to 30th September.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot 1 District Lot 1924 and Lot 2 District Lots 1035S, 1924, and 1925 both of Similkameen Division Yale District Plan EPP41102 of which 10.522 hectares may be irrigated.
- h) The authorized works are intake, pipe, and sprinklers which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.

k) This Licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence Number 31942.
