## *Water Act*

### CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert, store and use water as follows:

- a) The streams on which the rights are granted are Rain Shadow Spring No. 1, Rain Shadow Spring No. 2, Rain Shadow Spring No. 3 and storage is in 3 dugouts.
- b) The points of diversion are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is May 13, 2015.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are storage (non-power) and irrigation.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be held in storage is 6500 cubic metres per year and the maximum quantity of stored water which may be diverted for irrigation purpose is 6500 cubic metres per year, subject to the water being available from storage.
- f) The period of the year during which water may be held in storage is the whole year, and the period of the year in which the stored water may be used for irrigation purpose is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is That part of Lot 19, District Lot 8, Cameron District, Plan 1981, lying to the South of a boundary parallel to the South boundary of said lot and extending from a point on the Westerly boundary of said lot distant 11.642 chains Northerly from the South West corner of said lot except that part in Plan 19349, of which 2.14 hectares may be irrigated.
- h) The authorized works are dugouts, intakes, pumps, pipe and sprinklers which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2018. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
