

Province of British Columbia Water Sustainability Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is the Salmon River.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 3rd of December, 1971.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is irrigation.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for irrigation is 42,828.80 cubic metres per year.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is April 1 to September 30.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot A, Sections 16 and 21, Township 17, Range 11, West of the 6th Meridian, Kamloops Division Yale District, Plan 29247 except Plan KAP91950 of which 6.985 hectares may be irrigated.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, pump, pipe, sprinklers, and water meter, which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) With the exception of the water meter, the construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- i) This Licence is issued in substitution of C053157.
- k) The diversion of water authorized under this licence may be restricted or prohibited at any time by an Order in writing of an Engineer under the Water Sustainability Act, in order to maintain a minimum flow in the stream.
- The licensee shall install a flow meter or other measuring device to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the Water Sustainability Act.
- m) The licensee shall retain flow meter/measurement records for inspection upon request by an Engineer under the Water Sustainability Act.

n) This licence is issued under the Water Sustainability Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
